

What is the Virtual Resource Center?

(Updated 7/20/2017)

The Virtual Resource Center is set up for 3 areas of need: 1 hour interactive between a VRC facilitator and a student for A-G courses, CTE courses delivered in all areas taught by CTE credentialed teacher, and online use of digital texts (this year for the 4th-8th Pearson Interactive Science & 9-12 Pearson My Perspectives English).

What courses will be available?

A-G One Hour Interactive Classes (Students will be using the bundled texts with the PLS modules for assignments; this is simply an hour of interactive instruction based on those assignments. Parents and ISTs responsible for scoring and evaluation of student work)

1. A-G English 9
2. A-G English 10
3. A-G World History

CTE - Taught by a CTE designated subject teacher

1. Introduction to Theater
2. Introduction to Business
3. Introduction to Information Technology
4. Introduction to Education

Pearson English Perspectives Grade 9-12. All students will receive access to the online edition of their book and will include video, recorded journal assignments and optional auto-graded writing prompts which give feedback while writing. These 4 classes will not have a teacher interacting with students. Scoring of auto-graded assignments available to be viewed by student, parents, and ISTs.

Pearson Interactive Science Grades 4-8. All online assignments include interactive assignments, interactive labs, lesson quizzes and tests. There is no teacher interaction with these courses. This allows the student access to the online assignments. These five classes will not have a teacher interacting with students. These courses are to ease the access to the digital materials.
